Getting Started

Download and Unzip the Template

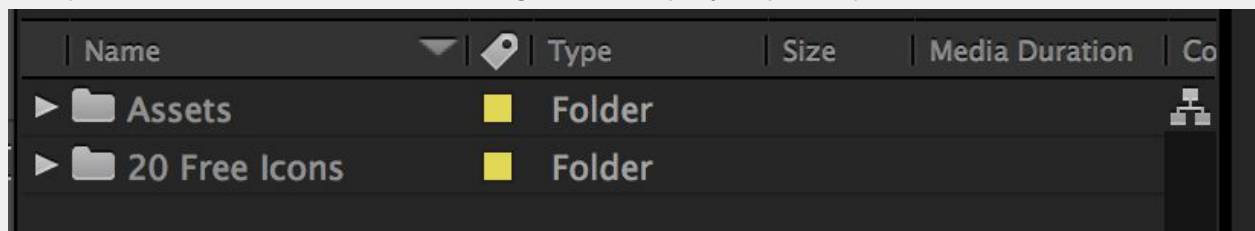
Your files will download as a .zip file. Simply unzip and double click on the After Effects project file. If you are reading this document, you have probably already completed this step.

Using the Pre-Rendered Footage

The pre-rendered footage is incredibly easy to edit with. All you need to do is simply import the footage into your NLE (Video Editing Application) of choice and place the icons above your original footage. If you want the icons to animate out you can simply duplicate the animation then reverse the speed.

Using the After Effects Project

The project file is optimized for After Effects CC and CS6. This means you can open the project in any version of After Effects CS6 or higher. In the project panel, you will see two folders:



The 'Assets' folder just has a series of assets for your project and you shouldn't need to access them for any reason. The '20 Free Icons' folder is where all of the animated icons can be found. Each icon is it's own individual composition and it should be noted that you can simultaneously open the 'Icons' project file in another After Effects project.
